 SIP (also known as Session Initiation Protocol) is considered the modern form of delivering telephone calls by using your IP Network.

How does this work?

West Pier's Media Converter works in the following way:

- 1. Your telephone lines (ISDN) and internet connection (LAN) are connected to the West Pier Media Converter.
- 2. The West Pier Media Converter changes your ISDN connection to a SIP connection over an IP Network, whilst consolidating your internet connection.
- 3. With SIP enabled on your current phone system, your business now has a low cost alternative to making outbound calls.
